OLD BUSINESS FROM FIRST MEETING:

- 1. Permanent Signs for the Parking Lot:** Update: one parent donated "yard sale signs" for now until permanent signs are made. UPDATE: Diocese is currently reviewing signage, we need to wait until we have their input to create permanent signage. DISCUSSION: should paying for signage be a Parent Association project. Discussion on the design, cost and installation of sign. Lisa O. of Development will research signs and present information at future meeting including a potential "mock up" of entrance sign. Estimated cost \$1,600. If the balance of the signs to be completed by the school are not to be purchased and installed until next year the Parent Assn. will move forward with another project. Update: We have pictures and a mockup of the sign for the meeting! Additional projects for consideration is to add more/better student seating outside the Spirit Store or pay for field trips for teacher's to learn La Sallian way? UPDATE: We voted to go with the sign project for this year. Due to increased pricing we will only be able to donate the main entrance sign. The price for the version we liked is now between \$1800 and 1900 not including install. Cathy and Amy confirmed the money was available (now that we don't have to pay for a new couch in the teacher's lounge). Next year we can consider the additional projects mentioned, more motivation signs or something new. This section will remain in Old Business until installation. **Update: appears signs will need to wait until summer, as we may have the parking lot redone. Do we want to pick another project? Second project idea was: new seating outside the Campus store. UPDATE 1/10/18: We voted not to start a project. We can vote again next year or put more money towards signs. 3/14/18 update: Parking lot was approved by diocese!!!**

2. **We need officers in training for P.A.** We would like to try “co-officers”. **As Nan Webb has taken a new job with the school, I will be stepping down from office. Three people have volunteered to step up: Heide Taylor, Staci Benson and Mary Ordoyne. Please welcome our new officers in training.**
3. **Kendra Scott:** We raised **\$750.00** the check should arrive by the end of January! Did the check arrive? Great job ladies. **Thank you to Mary Ordoyne, Nancy Ludwig and Carmen Vantu. Great success!** Tara Taylor was informed of the results. Once the check is received, this topic will be removed from old business.
4. **Replacing plastic chains with real chains in parking lot-** We discussed the plastic chains in the parking lot, apparently we cannot use real chains due to codes for the passing through of emergency vehicles. The administration will look at alternatives. **Changes in this area will be postponed until after the parking lot paving is completed.**
5. **Service hours (at least 15 hours) are due by 12/8 and 10 more by 4/6.** Any questions about service hours should be sent to Sheila Garcia.
6. **Prom-** Do we have a budget? The senior class has \$4,881.12 in their account. The prom is largely paid for by the ticket price. We confirmed that Mount Carmel at St. Jude has the date saved for us. I have asked the senior parents in attendance to start pushing for PROM answers, like theme, ticket pricing, etc....Prom is on 4/27.
7. **Tracking SAT scores at the school using Naviance.** Mr. Bernot is researching this and will discuss the topic at the next meeting. 3/14/18 Update: Mr. Bernot has been discussing this topic with Guidance and it will be on the agenda for a Coffee Talk before the end of the year watch your email.
8. **Measuring DAS results?.** Mr. Bernot is researching this and will discuss the topic at the next meeting. Ms. Jenny Mulhal is back and will be spearheading this topic. She is currently tracking but too early to report.
9. La Sallian Satus: We did it! This will be removed for next meeting.

Other New Business:

Security of our school: We reviewed Mr. Bernot’s email on the topic. Parents at the meeting were interested in finding out about armed security guards, gate management, more cameras (12 are coming), panic buttons, and student/ staff reminders that if you see something say something!

March for our Lives: parents were given information on the walk. This can be removed for meeting, no follow up needed.
