

Dress Code Guidelines

Dress Code for male students:

- Pants must be worn appropriately (i.e. not rolled up and must be dress pants—no jeans)
- Collared dress shirt with sleeves and worn with a tie (exception: tux shirt with a bowtie), shirts must remain tucked in for the entire dance
- Jackets or blazers are required

Dress Standards for female students:

- Bare midriffs and plunging necklines are not allowed.
- The back of the dress may not be lower than the natural waistline (belly button)
- See-through material will not be permitted
- Slits may not be higher than fingertip length
- Short dresses must be no shorter than 4' above the knee

*Students who arrive and do not meet the dress code guidelines are subject to being excluded from the event and no refund will be provided as agreement is provided on the dance memorandum. We want everyone to enjoy the night!
