SJPII Policy on Medication

Students are not permitted to carry prescription or non-prescription medications while on campus. All medications are required to be stored in the school Clinic and each medication, whether prescription or non-prescription, must have a signed Diocesan Authorization for Medication Form. This form is available in the school Clinic Office or by clicking [HERE](#).

Exceptions to this policy may be made for the use, supply and administration of an epinephrine auto-injection (EpiPen). If a student must carry an EpiPen, the school Clinic Office will still require a Diocesan Authorization Medication Form signed by their doctor.
