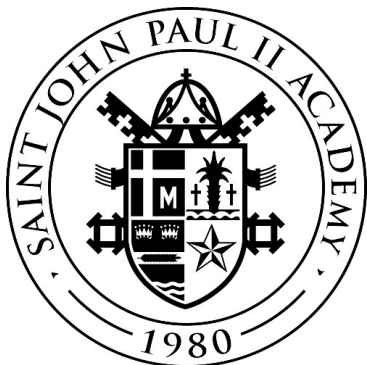

COLLEGE PLACEMENT
