

Presidential Merit Scholarship Criteria

Each year incoming freshmen students are selected from the pool of applicants who test on the official HSPT test date to receive a merit scholarship worth \$5000, renewable for four (4) years, provided they continue to meet the academic criteria.

Students must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship:

- You must have a completed application on file.
- You must take the HSPT at SJPII on the first Saturday in December.
- Candidates must have a 3.5 GPA in core courses for seventh and eighth grades.
- No disciplinary issues, including excessive tardiness or absences.
- Scholarship winners must maintain a 3.0 GPA or better in core courses each year in high school to renew this scholarship. In addition they must meet all the codes of conduct including absences and tardies expected of a SJPII student.
- Parents must actively support fund raising efforts by the school.

You do not need to apply for this scholarship. All students who test on the first Saturday in December at SJPII will be considered for the scholarship. The Scholarship Committee will review the qualified candidates and recipients will be notified with their acceptance letters.
