Frequently Asked Questions

What are some of the goals of the campaign?

Our main goal is to raise \$4 million dollars to install a new Turf Field and build two buildings. One building adjacent to the turf which will be used for restrooms and concessions and a second building west of our gym that will be a new weight room, locker rooms, film room, referee lounge, and office space for athletics.

Why now? Why this?

After a three-month feasibility study, we have determined enhancing our facility is a crucial next step in improving our school. This will help us remain competitive in the school market, strengthen our connections with alumni, parents, and students, and ensure we provide the best possible experience for every student—especially our student athletes.

Who is behind this campaign?

We have actively listened to administrators, coaches, faculty and staff, students, and community members to ensure this project aligns with the needs of our campus. The campaign is led by a dedicated group of staff, community volunteers, parents, and alumni who are committed to maintaining transparency and accountability throughout the process. Concessions and Bathrooms: Start: Winter 2025-2026 Finish: Spring 2026

Athletic Field House: Start: Spring 2026 Finish: Spring 2027
