## High School Placement Test

All freshman applicants are required to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT). The applicant's score on the HSPT will be an important factor in their acceptance and placement.

- Applicant's must have an application on file by Thursday, 10/23/25 to sit for the Saturday, 10/25/25 exam or by Thursday, 12/4/25 to sit for the Saturday, 12/6/24 exam
- To be eligible for scholarships, the applicant must test on one of the two official High School Placement test dates (10/25/25 or 12/6/25)
- If the applicant cannot sit for the test on the date assigned after submitting the application, please contact\_admissions@sjpii.net
