

Jean Schwager Seewald College Science Scholarship

The Jean Schwager Seewald College Science Scholarship honors the life of Jean Schwager Seewald. There will be a total of six scholarships of \$5,000 offered each year to students who are interested in studying one of the natural or applied sciences. Two outstanding seniors will be selected from each of the three Catholic high schools in the Diocese of Palm Beach: Cardinal Newman High School, John Carrol High School, and Saint John Paul II Academy.

To be considered for one of the \$5,000 scholarships offered, candidates must:

- Possess an unweighted cumulative high school GPA of at least 3.2.
- Have been admitted to a four-year accredited college or university.
- Intend to major in one of the natural or applied sciences.
- Submit a well-written, one page letter of interest in the scholarship that outlines what has prompted their decision to pursue their selected major as well as their future aspirations.
- A copy of a resume that highlights honors, extra, and co-curricular activities, and service achievements.
- A copy of a high school transcript that includes four years of science.

Applications are to be submitted to the Saint John Paul II Counseling Department .

Deadline for submission is April 15.

Award recipients will be notified by May 1 each year.
