

## The Alice and Anthony Borello Scholarship

Bishop Gerald M. Barbarito, Bishop of Palm Beach, is pleased to announce the Alice and Anthony Borello Scholarship, which will be awarded annually to four students during their senior year. The students must attend one of the three diocesan Catholic high schools: Cardinal Newman High School, John Carrol High School and St John Paul II Academy. Each school will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 for college tuition. The fourth scholarship will rotate among the three high schools as noted below. A bequest was made to the diocese by Anthony Borello in 2014 establishing these scholarships to help defray college tuition expensed; the scholarships are awarded based upon the economic need of the student.

High-school seniors wishing to apply are required to submit the following:

- Cover page includes the student's full name, address. Phone number, name of high school, name of college he/she plans to attend (include acceptance status), and a complete list of colleges where applications were submitted;
- **One-page** typed essay that addresses the applicant's desire to attend college, future aspiration, and what a Catholic school education has meant to him/her;
- Transcript of all high school grades through the first semester of the senior year, as well as class rank and GPA;
- Copy of the family tax return from the previous year, OR the financial aid application to their respective high school (that was submitted for their senior year) OR an alternate verification of financial need. Qualifying students will have a demonstrated economic need.

Applications are to be submitted to the Saint John Paul II Academy Counseling Department by March 13th
